

## THURGOOD MARSHALL BAR ASSOCIATION 2024 SUMMER ASSOCIATE PROGRAM

The Thurgood Marshall Bar Association ("TMBA") is an Orange County, California-based non-profit organization committed to connecting, supporting, and increasing the Black legal community in Orange County and to promoting diversity, professional improvement, and the advancement of justice. As part of that commitment, TMBA has designed the 2024 Summer Associate Program to provide law students committed to promoting diversity within the legal community with substantive legal and professional experiences to support their development as attorneys. Summer Associate Program participants are provided the opportunity to work under the guidance of Program Partners as part of an eight (8) to ten (10) week, full-time program, tentatively beginning on Monday, May 20, 2024.

**ELIGIBILITY:** 

The applicant must be a first or second-year law student. Law students from racial and ethnic groups historically underrepresented in the legal profession are encouraged to apply. The applicant must be in good academic standing.

**CRITERIA:** 

Eligible law students should submit their application, resumes, transcripts, and one writing sample (five pages maximum) to info@thurgoodmarshallbarassociation.org. To be clear, applicant information must be submitted ELECTRONICALLY. Resumes should include the name and contact information of two (2) references, as well as all law clerk related experience, and must be received by the deadline. If the applicant's law school must mail the transcript, transcripts should be mailed to Thurgood Marshall Bar Association, P.O. Box 6130, Newport Beach, CA 92658. Applicants who must mail their transcript should also electronically submit a "grade report" listing their courses and grades in Word format.
